Most recently Emma had the amazing opportunity to attend classes at The Martha Graham School (NYC), Steps on Broadway (NYC) and The Ailey School (NYC). Emma has also been in many local performances as a member of Cobequid Dance Academy's Cobequid Young Company.

At CDA she has taken workshops with Darryl Tracy (TDT), Ballet Bob (NBS), Sion Irwin-Childs, Marcia Dysart and many others over the years.
